EVENT DESCRIPTION

Over the course of this one-day event, we will be highlighting several of the teaching cases developed by Babson College for the Lancet Commission on Global Surgery. Faculty from Harvard and Babson as well as partners from low- and middle-income countries will lead participants through case discussions. These discussions will review best practices for improving access to and quality of surgical care worldwide, and reflect on how to develop sustainable, resilient surgical systems for low-resource countries. We will consider further applications for the case series along with the training of surgeons and healthcare managers involved in Global Surgery.
